Power Seats The power seat controls are located on the outboard side of the front seat cushions.



The massage cycle will run continuously for up to 10 minutes and can be interrupted by pushing the lumbar control down briefly. Use the power seat control first to get the proper position. When the ignition is turned to ON, press the top of the power lumbar control where it is marked AUTO to activate the adaptive feature. Be aware that there are special things to know about safety belts and children. And there are different rules for smaller children and babies. If a child will be riding in your vehicle, see the part of this manual called "Children.". Be sure to use the correct buckle when buckling your shoulder belt. If you find that the latch plate will not go fully into the buckle, see if you are using the buckle for the center passenger position. In a crash, you wouldn't have the full width of the belt to spread impact forces. If a belt is twisted, make it straight so it can work properly, or ask your dealer to fix it. The belt should go back out of the way. Before you close the door, be sure the belt is out of the way. If you slam the door on it, you can damage both the belt and your vehicle. When a safety belt is worn properly, it's more likely that the fetus won't be hurt in a crash. For pregnant women, as for anyone, the key to making safety belts effective is wearing them properly.

Wearing your safety belt during a crash helps reduce your chance of hitting things inside the vehicle or being ejected from it. If you're too close to an inflating air bag, as you would be if you were leaning forward, it could seriously injure you. Safety belts help keep you in position for air bag inflation before and during a crash. The system checks the air bag electrical system for malfunctions. The light tells you if there is an electrical problem. The driver's side impact air bag is in the side of the driver's seatback closest to the door. 127. The path of an inflating air bag must be kept clear. Don't put anything between an occupant and an air bag, and don't attach or put anything on the steering wheel hub or on or near any other air bag covering and don't let seat covers block. For frontal air bags, inflation is determined by the angle of the impact and how quickly the vehicle slows down in frontal and near frontal impacts. This dust could cause breathing problems for people with a history of asthma or other breathing trouble. To avoid this, everyone in the vehicle should get out as soon as it is safe to do so. If you have breathing problems but can't get out of the vehicle after an air bag inflates, then get fresh air by opening a window or a door. You may have to replace the air bag module in the steering wheel, both the air bag module and the instrument panel for the right front passenger's air bag, or both the air bag module. You'll find them on the buckle end of the safety belts for the driver and right front passenger. They help the safety belts reduce a person's forward movement in a moderate to severe crash in which the front of the vehicle hits something. Make sure the release button on the buckle is positioned so you would be able to unbuckle the safety belt quickly if you ever had to. Don't let it get twisted. The shoulder belt may lock if you pull the belt across you very quickly. In a crash, this applies force to the strong pelvic bones. CAUTION You can be seriously hurt if your shoulder belt is too loose. In a crash, you would move forward too much, which could increase injury. When installed on a shoulder belt, the comfort guide better positions the belt away from the neck and head. The elastic cord must be under the belt. Then, place the guide over the belt, and insert the two edges of the belt into the slots of the guide. 3. Be sure that the belt

In a crash, an infant in a rear facing seat settles into the restraint, so the crash forces can be distributed across the. Make sure that the infant's head rests toward the center of the vehicle. A child restraint system is any device designed for use in a motor vehicle to restrain, seat, or position children. A built in child restraint system is a permanent part of the motor vehicle. An add child restraint system is a portable one, which is purchased by the vehicle's owner.

This is because the back of the rear facing child restraint would be very close to the inflating air bag. Always secure a rear facing child restraint in a rear seat. For it to work, a top strap must be properly anchored to the vehicle. If the child restraint does not have a top strap, one can be obtained, in kit form, for many child restraints. Be sure to use an anchor point located on the same side of the vehicle as the seating position where the child restraint will be placed. If you have an adjustable head restraint, raise the head restraint and route the top strap under it. See the earlier part about the top strap if the child restraint has one. Be sure to follow the instructions that came with the child restraint. Secure the child in the child restraint when and as the instructions say. If you're using a forward facing child restraint, you may find it helpful to use your knee to push down on the child. Never put a rear facing child restraint in this seat. But if a safety belt isn't long enough to fasten, your dealer will order you an extender. It's free.

When you go in to order it, take the heaviest coat you will wear, so the extender will be long enough for you. When unlocking the driver's door, you can unlock the other doors by holding the key in the turned position for a few seconds or by quickly turning the door key twice in the lock cylinder. Remote Keyless Entry System With this feature, you can lock and unlock your doors or unlock your trunk from about 3 feet 1 m up to 30 feet 9 m away using the remote keyless entry transmitter supplied with your vehicle. If a transmitter is lost or stolen, a replacement can be purchased through your dealer.

Also use this gear to rock your vehicle back and forth to get out of snow, ice or sand without damaging your transaxle. You can use it on very steep hills, or in deep snow or mud. If the shift lever is put in FIRST 1, the transaxle won't shift into first gear until the vehicle is going slowly enough. NOTICE If your front wheels can't turn, don't try to drive. If the ignition is on, the BRAKE indicator light on the instrument panel cluster should come on. If it doesn't, you need to have your vehicle serviced. If the parking brake does not release, your vehicle needs service. 232 NOTICE Driving with the parking brake on can cause your rear brakes to overheat. Your vehicle can roll. If you have left the engine running, the vehicle can move suddenly. If you can leave your vehicle with the ignition key in your hand, your vehicle is in PARK P. Your vehicle could move suddenly if the shift lever is not fully in PARK P with the parking brake firmly set. When the light sensor reads darkness outside and the parking lamps are active, the digital displays can be adjusted by turning the lamp control knob counterclockwise to dim and clockwise to. When this occurs, the rear window defogger may take slightly longer to clear the glass, the heated seats may not get as warm as they usually do and the fan blower may cut back to a lower speed.
